

More devotional helps you can use

Lectio365 is a guided Bible devotion and prayer application for your phone or tablet. This devotional takes approximately 15 minutes. It is calm, Scriptural, and paced for your participation. You may find it wherever you download apps for your phone. (This is an outreach of the Episcopal or Anglican Church.)

First15 is an app and a web site that you can access daily. These devotions include Bible verses along with a devotional reading, questions to consider and guided prayer. These include some devotional music you may or may choose not to listen to. They are intended to take about 15 minutes to complete. If you are new to reading the Bible this is good as it stresses who God is, what He does, and how to have conversation with Him (pray). You may find it online at: <https://www.first15.org/> You can read on-line or sign up for an email reminder each day. You can download the app wherever you download apps for your phone.

YouVersion is a powerful app for your phone or tablet. It offers a multitude of Bible Study and Devotionals. You choose what you want to read or study. It keeps track of where you are in the study and opens to the next day's lesson when you return. You can have it remind you or you can just go whenever you desire. You choose from a huge variety of translations that you may download or read online. If you enjoy hearing the Bible read aloud, you may like to try the NIV UK version and listen to David Suchet read. You can download the app wherever you download apps for your phone. (The logo is a red book with the title Holy Bible.)
